

# <u>Challenge</u>

Each week we set a challenge for your child. This is an opportunity for you to support your child in their learning and for you to find out about what we do in school. Please complete the challenge each week as the children feel left out if their friends have done it and they haven't! All challenges need to be in school no later than the Thursday.

#### FS1 & FS2

We have been working on 'patterns' in maths focussing on various ways of making a pattern using a variety of resources. The children have been looking at patterns based on colour, shape and size using resources found in our maths area and outside e.g. red counter, green counter, red counter, green counter and conker, leaf, conker leaf. We would like your child to independently, where possible, making their own pattern using autumn things.



#### Topic- FS1

We have been learning about Autumn and made hedgehogs out of playdough. On Friday we talked about Bonfire night and fireworks. In Maths we have been making patterns using a variety of objects.

# Topic- FS2

We have been learning about All Saint's Day, remembering those Saints who have died who have done wonderful things for us. We remembered our class Saint, St Francis, who loved animals and always helped people in need.

All Soul's Day is a time where we remember our family and friends who have died and talk about all the wonderful things they did to love, help and support us. On Friday we talked about Bonfire night. The children remebered what celebrations happen as we discussed fireworks etc in circle time. They made firework pictures using coloured chalk on black card, creating different patterns.
