## Challenge

Each week we set a challenge for your child. This is an opportunity for you to support your child in their learning and for you to find out about what we do in school. Please complete the challenge each week as the children feel left out if their friends have done it and they haven't! All challenges need to be in school no later than the Thursday.

#### FS1

Over our half term break please can you support your child with a challenge. As part of our Maths work in Autumn 1 we have been learning about things that are long and short. For the challenge, if you go out on a walk, please could you search for some sticks and talk about which are long and short. If you find several you could play at ordering them from shortest to longest. Encourage your child to use the correct language to describe them. Please can you take a photo of your sticks and send them on dojo. We'll show the photos of sticks/your walk and talk about them in class.

#### **FS2**

Over the Half Term holiday, we would like you and your child to go on an Autumn Walk. We would like your child to make an Autumn collage/picture, either with things they have collected on the walk or with photos of Autumn things they have found. They could even draw things they saw too. Please bring this into school after the holiday, no later than Thursday as we would love to display them.

#### Topic- FS1

We have been looking at the artist LS Lowry and his paintings that included cats and dogs. We have painted a cat or dog, thinking about their features and choosing appropriate colours.

## Rhymes/poems and songs:


The Grand Old Duke of York, 5 Little ducks, 1,2,3,4,5 Once I caught a fish alive.
