

## Summary Impact Report of PPG 2015-2016

### KS2 2015-2016 results

- Significantly above National in Reading, Maths and Grammar/Spelling.
- KS2 combined was also above National - % at Expected or above

### Closing the Gap

- The Average Scaled Score for 12 FSM (ever) children was 105.8 which is significantly above National average and is 0.8 above Non-FSM.

- FSM (ever) Pupil Progress - Average Scaled score was +3.4 compared to National Av scaled score and greater than Non FSM.

- KS1 combined were above National -% at Expected or above.
- Y2 – with the largest number of Pupil Premium Children the gap significantly narrowed in Attainment and Progress Steps from Autumn Term to Summer Term.

### EYFS

- Good Level of Development has seen an upward trend - 80% 2016 compared to 69% National and local authority.

### Year 1 Phonics

- 87% of children passed the Phonics test. Above National

**In ALL classes** from Year 1-6 Progress gaps between Non-Pupil Premium and Pupil Premium narrowed from the beginning to the end of the year indicating provision
